In attendance were Todd Mickelson, George Maliglig, Ken Wallace, Clay Casteel, Jamie Beans, Tim Shields, James Beans, Vonnice Wallace, and Teresa Herberger. President Todd Mickelson called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Auxiliary report: Teresa is now is working on getting the casino donations for Appreciation Dinner.

Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were distributed and read. A motion to accept the corrected minutes was made by George and seconded by Ken.

Financial report: June financial report was distributed and read. A motion to accept the financial report as presented was made by Tim and seconded by Ken. Jamie stated that we will need to start thinking about our budget for next May and increasing the tax levy. The biggest thing we need to address is Measure 53 our budget is \$16,000 which doesn't cover half of our insurance premium. Another thing is fuel costs and as we have spent \$10,000 in fuel cost so far this year.

Vehicles: Clay reported that vehicle 4270 needs air conditioner fixed.

Chief Report: EMT class will be starting Tuesday July 14, 2026. We have 7 students.

Captain Report: We have received \$2500 Grant from Oregon Health Authority. Also from Ford Family Foundation a Grant for \$4500. for the EMT program. A donation was received by Carrie Mock for \$2,000 to the EMT program. Carrie also donated \$1,000 for Fun Days. We received a canned water donation from the National Volunteer Fire Council. The Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Tribe of Indians gave us a grant for \$11,000 to cover the cost and installation of six new electric garage door openers for the apparatus bay which will be installed July 21st. We have received eleven radios from the County FEMA Grant. James said he has applied to the Oregon Community Foundation for a \$40,000 grant for kitchen equipment and to include the electrical wiring. James also applied for 12 sets of turnouts and 11 SCBA's from the FEMA Assistance Firefighter's Grant which amounts to approximately \$260,000.

We are at 98 calls year to date. The last of the turn out lockers are being powder coated and the turn out lockers will be done.

New Business: The Budget has been accepted by the County and the paperwork has been filed.

Sand Drags are this weekend.

A date has been set for the second annual car wash fund raiser which will be on Saturday, August 15th at the station.

Started working on the SORREN review which the State requires.

A motion to adjourn made by George and seconded by Ken. This meeting came to a close at 5:40.
